We are writing because the afterschool program at your school is participating in a field test of measures of skill development and positive behavior change for use in California's After School Education Safety (ASES) programs. Program sites participating in this field test will receive summary reports of their students' performance on the measures.

The California Afterschool Outcome Measures Project, with support from the David and Lucile Packard Foundation and the California Department of Education, has developed online surveys to respond to California Educational Code 8484 that requires the State to provide ASES grantees with the option to choose, as their accountability assessment, measures of skill development and positive behavior change.
